The unsightly silver grey/black material shown in the photograph is dental amalgam, which was first used to fill teeth in 1818. The material is a mixture combining 50% Mercury with other metals. Mercury is highly dangerous to all animal life causing a wide variety of ailments in humans and animals alike. It was widely believed that once the filling was placed in a tooth it remained bound in that filling material and could not escape into the body to cause any problems. This, so called fact, has been **disproven many, many times** and a study at Tübingen University¹ on 18,000 people clearly proved that mercury is constantly released and the amount doubles when chewing or drinking acidic liquids such as Orange juice.

The larger the number of fillings the larger the amount of Mercury ingested.

A recent study published in the Journal of Alzheimer's Disease 22 (2010) 1–18 DOI 10.3233/JAD2010100705 IOS Press² concluded that:-

**Mercury is the most probable cause of Alzheimer's disease and
Dental Amalgam is the most probable source of that Mercury.**
