

MY STORY – M.R.

The prelude to my fortunate discovery of the Munro Hall Clinic, and subsequent highly successful treatment was not nearly as dramatic as some of the stories I heard from other patients I met in their waiting room. I suffered for a long time from a slow decline in vitality, along with 'migrating' symptoms such as severe headaches, frequent colds which always progressed down my throat and ended up on my chest, blurring vision, depression, weight gain which did not respond to dieting, food allergies, loss of energy and skeletal problems with lower back and neck. 2. Extraction of root-filled teeth which had become infected. This infection had already passed into my blood, and was so serious that a homeopath I consulted around that time told me that within months my major organs could have begun to malfunction.
3. Removal of impacted wisdom tooth. This problem was detected by analysis of a Cavitat scan, as the whole area was infected, and this did not show on a regular OPG from the hospital.
4. Cleaning of cavitations. There was a large cavitation under a tooth to which a crown had been fitted by my previous dentist. It contained a mix of metals, and I'd long complained of bleeding and pain from under this crown. The sub-clinical infection had eroded the jawbone underneath this area.

I believe I have been prevented from declining into chronic illness. I feel huge relief, as my physical energy is no longer being consumed by fighting off infection. I have been told that I look 20 years younger, and I have energy levels to match that!

I think about the global implications of what I have experienced, and feel astounded at the mis-information, commercial distortion of crucial health issues, and the rank intransigence of the dental/medical profession. Basically anywhere that Western dental technology is used, people are being poisoned wholesale
